Study Guide Overview

God calls us to live with hearts that are **broken over sin**, leading us into **deeper surrender to Jesus** and **greater compassion for people who do not yet know Him**.

Key Idea

Heal my heart and make it clean

Open up my eyes to the things unseen

Show me how to love like you have loved me

Break my heart for what breaks yours

Everything I am for your Kingdom's cause

As I walk from earth into eternity

A heart that is broken over sin:

1. **Leads us to surrender to God**
2. **Leads us to compassion for others**

Scripture Reading

Read together **Psalm 51**

David wrote this psalm after being confronted with his sin. Instead of running from God, he ran **toward God with a broken and repentant heart**.



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Small Group Questions/Discussions

1. A broken heart Over Sin

- What stands out to you about David's response to his sin?
- Why do people often try to hide, minimise, or shift blame for sin?
- Why is recognising the seriousness of sin important for our relationship with God?
- Paul describes the inner struggle with sin in Romans 7. How do you see that struggle in your own life?

2. A broken heart Leads to Surrender

- Romans 8 says there is **no condemnation for those in Christ Jesus**. What does that mean for us?
- In the sermon, Brony suggested surrender as a **continual heart posture**, not just a one-time event. What might it look like in real life to live continually surrendered?
- Why do we sometimes try to take back control from God?

3. A broken heart Leads to Compassion

- How does recognising our own need for grace change how we see others?
- What might it look like for God to "break our hearts for what breaks His"?
- What are practical ways we can share the hope of Jesus with the people around us?

Personal Reflection

Take a moment to quietly reflect:

- Is there an area of sin God is asking you to bring before Him?
- Is there something in your life you need to surrender again?
- Is there someone God is placing on your heart who needs to know Jesus?
